The MCHC Foundation highlights include purchasing a Podiatry chair, IV fluid/blanket warmer, surgery lights, and treadmills for Monroe County Hospital & Clinics. Also, providing scholarship opportunities for Albia, Moravia and Eddyville/Blakesburg/Fremont Community School Districts.
